Busing for 4K is available for all students, but many families have noted it may not be ideal for everyone and is not required. We have a limited number of routes; therefore, some students in the AM classes may need to leave 4K early if they use district transportation and PM students may be late getting to 4K if they take advantage of district busing.

We offer door-to-door transportation service at mid-day. Rural AM students will ride regular bus routes to school and door-to-door transportation will be offered home. Rural PM students will get door-to-door transportation to school and then will ride regular bus routes home at the end of the day. In-town students will get door-to-door transportation one way as well at mid-day, similar to rural students. For in-town students, there is no before school transportation for AM students or after school transportation for PM students except to existing in-town regular bus route stops. More information will be out later regarding transportation, but this is something you should start thinking about right now.
