

Key Points

- Heat Advisories and Excessive Heat Warnings from Monday may need to be extended into Tuesday afternoon, and could include all counties (even bordering Lake Michigan).
- A weak cold front approaches from the north on Tuesday afternoon through Tuesday night. If clouds arrive as early as Tuesday afternoon, temps and heat indices could be much cooler than shown.
- Storm chances remain low (around 15%) Tuesday afternoon, increasing to 20-30% chance in the evening as the front draws closer. In the unlikely event these storms develop, they could become severe, with large hail and damaging wind gusts.

Values are maximums over the period beginning at the time shown.


